

None expected. The respondent has not given notice of its intention to oppose the application.

5. Estimated duration: If unopposed, 15 minutes.

6. Reading of the affidavits:

It is necessary to read the founding affidavit. The annexures to the founding affidavit are sufficiently described in the affidavit itself, and it is suggested that it is not necessary to peruse them independently. A concise supplementary affidavit was delivered on 8 July 2020, and it is submitted that it is necessary to also read the supplementary affidavit.

7. Service:

- (a) The sheriff served the application at the respondent's registered address (which is also its main place of business) on 1 July 2020.

- (b) A copy of the application was also emailed to the respondent's sole director, Mr Breedt, on 3 July 2020.
- (c) There was compliance with section 346(4A) on 1 July 2020 when the sheriff attempted to serve the application on employees and trade unions. As the respondent's office (at its registered address and main place of business) was found locked, the application was affixed to the main entrance.

8. Certificate of urgency in terms of the 11 May 2020 Practice Directive:

A certificate as required by para. 90 of the 11 May 2020 Practice Directive is attached hereto.

9. Proposed order:

- (a) The notice of motion prays for a final liquidation order. As the Companies Act, unlike the Insolvency Act, does not require a final liquidation order to be preceded by a provisional order, the applicant will submit that a final liquidation order would under the prevailing circumstances be appropriate.
- (b) A copy of the proposed draft order will be uploaded onto the *CaseLines* system.

FOUNDING AFFIDAVIT

I, the undersigned,

ERLO BERNHARD PAUL

do hereby declare and state under oath:





1. I am an adult male person who currently resides at 17 Soetdoring Street, Bela Bela, Limpopo, 0480 .
2. The facts contained in this affidavit fall within my personal knowledge, unless the contrary appears from the context hereof, and I confirm such facts to be true and correct.

[A] APPLICANT

3. I am the applicant.
4. I act in my capacity as one of the respondent's many unpaid creditors. In accordance with section 346(1)(b) of the Companies Act, 61 of 1973 (the **Companies Act**) I have the requisite *locus standi* to apply for an order for the respondent's liquidation.

[B] RESPONDENT

5. The respondent is **VAULTAGE ALL ROUND SOLUTIONS (PTY) LIMITED** trading as **VAULTAGE SOLUTIONS**, a private profit company incorporated in accordance with the Companies Act, under registration number 2019/202858/07.
6. The respondent's registered address is situated at 12 Villa Amiel, Riviera Lane, Featherbrooke, Ext 8, Krugersdorp.



7. The respondent has only one director, being Willem J Breedt (**Breedt**), an adult male person with identity number 750714 501 3089.
8. The respondent's main place of business is situated at 12 Villa Amiel, Riviera Lane, Featherbrooke Ext 8, Krugersdorp.
9. The respondent's registered particulars are confirmed in a printout from the records of the Companies and Intellectual Property Commission, which is annexed hereto as "FA1".

[C] PURPOSE OF APPLICATION

10. I seek an order for the respondent's liquidation under circumstances where the respondent is indebted to me in an admitted amount of \$73,851.40 (more than R1,277,000.00), and is unable to pay such amount due to the fact that it owns no assets, and earns no income.
11. The respondent is both commercially and factually insolvent, and an order for its liquidation ought therefore to be granted in terms of section 344 of the Companies Act.
12. In addition to the respondent's dire financial position, its liquidation is also just, equitable, and desirable to ensure that its highly suspicious financial dealings are fully investigated by liquidators who will act in the best interest of the respondent's creditors.



[D] RELEVANT FACTS

13. During approximately May 2019 my daughter, Nadia Paul (**Nadia**), was told of a potentially lucrative investment opportunity involving crypto currency. This information was conveyed to Nadia by a financial broker, Anton Rogers (**Rogers**). Rogers informed Nadia that the respondent, represented by Breedt, was involved in crypto currency transactions, and that it generated profits of up to 5% per week.
14. Pursuant to the above Nadia made contact with Breedt and invested an initial amount of R30,000.00 with the respondent. After approximately three weeks Nadia requested a pay-out of US\$200 to test the pay-outs and the legitimacy of the investment. Nadia received the money without delay, and every week received an emailed statement to confirm that her investment had grown by 5%.
15. As Nadia was impressed with the profits earned on her initial investment, she informed her entire family (including me) of the investment opportunity. After some deliberation most of the members of our extended family decided to invest in the respondent's crypto currency business.
16. My personal capital investment amounted to US\$11,248.63, which is confirmed by the Certificate of Trade annexed hereto as "**FA2**". I point out that Breedt signed the certificate, and that the certificate reflects Logos and Insignia of several known crypto currency denominations. The certificate also

includes a type of registration number, being: "CIPC NR: 917506942". This number gives the certificate an official appearance, but with the benefit of hindsight the number has no apparent purpose or value.

17. Other members of the Paul-family also invested significant amounts of money with the respondent. Details of the investments made by the various members of the Paul-family, each reflected in a Certificate of Trade, are as follows:

(a)	Dian Paul (my son) -	\$2,158.27	("FA3")
(b)	Estelle Paul -	\$2,158.27	("FA4")
(c)	CH Paul -	\$11,248.63	("FA5")
(d)	Ruan Paul -	\$10,818.83	("FA6")

(f)	Paul Family 2 -	\$34,481.58	("FA8")
(g)	Nadia Paul -	<u>\$16,156.10</u>	("FA9")

18. In total, the initial capital investment amounted to \$112,236.92. At the prevailing exchange rate of R17.30 this amounts to R1,941,698.72.

19. Investments made with the respondent were not preceded by the conclusion of any formal agreements. The investment amounts were simply deposited into an FNB account, the detail of which was provided by Breedt.

Two handwritten signatures in black ink are located at the bottom right of the page. The first signature is a cursive 'J', and the second is a more stylized signature.

20. All correspondence received from the respondent were received directly from Breedt. I have never been personally introduced to any other persons employed by the respondent. I have, however, noticed that correspondence was received from more than one email address, including bot@myvaultage.com, and admin@myvaultage.com. It appears that Breedt corresponds from both these email addresses.
21. Pursuant to the investments made by the Paul-family we received weekly statements from the respondent (specifically from Breedt) informing us that our investments were performing well, and reflecting the ever-increasing value of our investments.
22. What we did not receive is any actual payment of profits – we merely received computer-generated statements reflecting the supposed value of our investments.
23. As an example of the aforesaid I annex hereto, as “FA10”, three of the monthly statements issued to me.
24. On 4 December 2019 Nadia (and the other investors) received an email from *The VaultAge Team* informing her that the crypto currency market was “*still hovering*”, that so-called experts expected the market to move up by 100%, but that the respondent managed to “*maintain the 5%*” (i.e. generated 5% growth). The same email informed Nadia that her investment was at the time worth \$44,605.29. A true copy of this email is annexed hereto as “FA11”.



25. On 3 January 2020 the respondent (represented by Breedl) addressed an email to investors, a copy of which is annexed hereto as "FA12". The subject of the email was *VaultAge Solutions Payment Update 03/01/2020*. The email informed investors that the respondent was experiencing problems with its ability to access the funds held with one of the crypto currency platforms known as Binance. The email informed investors as follows:

"We apologise to all members that we didn't give the full information as provided in this letter earlier. We will keep to this schedule and insure that every single member is paid. This has been an extremely testing time for VaultAge Solutions. I know that members also had frustrations to deal with and specially being the time of year that it is.

We have 3 trading accounts:

- 1. Binance 85% of the fund traded here*
- 2. Bittrex 10% of fund traded here*
- 3. Bitfinex 5% of fund trade here*

We only trade up to 50% of the fund available on each platform. The full fund is not traded at any time as this may be risky.

As the crypto world and the use of crypto develops are payment method more and more regulations will come through to make sure the traders are legit. There has been a drive to make sure that people are not using crypto for money laundering and they have been doing that globally. VaultAge Solutions have been asked by one of the platforms. Binance to supply relevant documentation with regards to what we do and how. We have submitted the documentation that was excepted by Binance but we are still waiting from them to verify it and allow us access to withdraw the profits again. THE FUNDS ARE SAFE AND NOTHING HAS HAPPENED TO IT. This is part of a global drive to make sure no money laundering takes place and VaultAge

Solutions will be approved by Binance soon. This will take 2 to 3 more working days. Unfortunately, this had a major effect on VaultAge Solutions with regards to the profit available to do the payments as the other two trading platforms has very small amount on trade compared to Binance. Along with the Blockchain wallet that we have not been able to access the last 3 weeks have really caused major delays. We have someone with Blockchain connections assisting us now and hopefully we can get that sorted ASAP as well. The flow of profit will then be enough to make sure every member is paid on time as per schedule. **INCLUDING ARREAR PAYMENTS.**

We sincerely apologize to every member and what stressed it caused over the last months. We have been working on contingencies to make sure nothing like this will happens again and that no matter what happens we can stick to the payment schedule.

1. I also want to explain the flow of transactions all the way to your wallet:
We receive the profits weekly from the trading platforms into our profit wallet (this use to be Blockchain wallet that we currently cannot use) we had to create new wallet in which we receive the funds.
2. From the profit wallet we in the past paid members manually. But now we transfer the funds to the payroll company and they then distribute it to all the members.


We don't want to make any empty promises regarding payments, or inaccurate information, and it is very clear that we need to get the two issues, Binance and Blockchain wallet resolved. We there for ask that everyone be patient just a little longer. We will be able to start with full payment schedule again on Tuesday as these issues will be sorted by then. I understand that the members have commitments but I don't want to make any empty promises that I know we cannot currently commit to. We need to be very accurate from now on."

26. Notwithstanding the above, by late February 2020 the problems apparently experienced by the respondent had still not been resolved.
27. On 24 February 2020 the respondent addressed a further email to investors providing an update on the issues. A true copy of such email is annexed hereto as "FA13". The email informed investors that the "*problem with the Blockchain wallet has not been resolved*" and that the problem could apparently be assigned to a "*software bug*".
28. On 4 March 2020 the respondent again addressed communications to its investors, informing us that although "*there has been a lot of resistance in the market, we [the respondent] had enough opportunity to generate 5% for this week*". A true copy of this email is annexed hereto as "FA14". The annexed email, which was addressed to Nadia, informed her that her initial investment of \$16,156.10 made during May 2019, had grown to \$68,550.91 in less than 10 months (growth of more than \$52,000 or R900,000).
29. On 12 April 2020, after no payments were made to any of the respondent's investors, an urgent email was received from the respondent. A true copy of the email titled *VaultAge Solutions – Urgent Message 12.04.2020*, is annexed hereto as "FA15". The email informed investors of an alleged smear campaign against the respondent, that the respondent had consulted with lawyers, and that it would deal with the person involved in the smear campaign "*severaly*" [sic].



30. To the best of my knowledge the respondent has to date hereof never instituted any legal action against investors or media outlets who have over the past two weeks published damning reports about both the respondent and Breedt.
31. Nevertheless, at the time when the Paul-family received the 12 April 2020 email we still believed the excuses proffered by Breedt, had not withdrawn our investments, and trusted that our investments were safe.
32. On 18 April 2020 a further email was received from the respondent. A true copy of such email is annexed hereto as "FA16". The email informed investors that the respondent's Binance account with 80% of the funds (presumably the funds invested by the respondent's clients) was blocked during November 2019 and remained blocked. In addition, the email also informed investors of problems (an alleged *Error*) experienced with its Blockchain wallet, but undertook to rectify the problems and to make overdue payments to investors in the foreseeable future.
33. A further email was received from the respondent on 22 April 2020. A true copy of the email is annexed hereto as "FA17", and informed investors that new payment systems had been put in place, and that the systems "*will ensure that all profit and Capital payments will be paid before close of business Friday*". The email effectively informed investors, who were at this stage already concerned about the problems experienced by the respondent, that the problems would be resolved by Friday 24 April 2020.



34. On Friday 24 April 2020, instead of making the overdue payments, the respondent addressed yet a further email to investors, a copy of which is annexed hereto as "FA18". The email informed investors that payment would start on 29 April and should be completed by 2 May 2020, but did not explain why it would take 3-days to make payments to investors. The email also referenced the public outcry against the respondent's suspicious business dealings in the following terms:

"I would also like to mention about the alleged allegations against VaultAge Solutions and the reason why we are not publically reacting on it. We have our legal team busy with the right defense and the right legal way of handling the alleged allegations. I know that members have been emailed and are concerned. We must handle it in the appropriate way as to not set a precedence [sic] for the future".

35. The reference to persons who invested capital with the respondent as "members" provides some insight into the way in which Breedt views investors. Apparently, to his mind, investors have become members of a club controlled by him.
36. On 28 April 2020 the respondent again addressed correspondence to its investors. A copy of the relevant email is annexed hereto as "FA19". The email informed investors that outstanding payments related to March 2020 would be paid on 28 and 29 April 2020, and that payments related to April 2020 would start thereafter. The email further included the following request (again to 'members') not to take legal action against the respondent:

"We appreciate every member and we understand the current financial uncertainty and the need to get funds in. This is one last request. I understand that there are people ready to make cases against VaultAge. But this is one last plea to all members."

37. On 29 April 2020 (the next day) a further email was received from the respondent. This email, a copy of which is annexed hereto as "FA20", informed investors that the persons listed in the email would receive payment on the day (i.e. on 29 April). I respectfully invite the attention of the Honourable Court to the long list of investors who had clearly already demanded payment from the respondent.
38. At the time the Paul-family had not requested the repayment of their investments from the respondent, and still believed that the respondent's business would normalise and that we would eventually receive payment of our capital and the very generous profits promised to us by the respondent and Breedt. Some of the members of our family did, however, request payment of some of the profits that accrued on their investments, but did not receive payments.
39. With the benefit of hindsight I now understand that the correspondence from the respondent was designed to lull investors into a false sense of security, and to prevent (or delay) litigation against the respondent and against Breedt.
40. The continued payment promises made by the respondent were followed by an email dated 3 May 2020, a copy of which is annexed hereto as "FA21", in

which the respondent conceded an inability to make payment to investors (which inability was not explained), and informed investors that:

- (a) Investments would be capped to the value it attained on Wednesday 29 April 2020;
- (b) Pay outs of the funds owed to all members would commence in the week of 4 May 2020;
- (c) Payments would be made every week, proportionally to the value of the total fund, until all amounts owed to investors were paid; and
- (d) It was anticipated that all payments would be completed by mid-July 2020.

41. The aforesaid email effectively communicated a decision to terminate the respondent's business venture and to pay all amounts owed to investors, including the Paul-family investors, in weekly instalments.

42. On 8 May 2020 the members of the Paul-family who invested in the respondent all received emails informing us of the value of our investments and the value of the payment we could expect during the week. True copies of such email are annexed hereto as "FA22". According to the respondent we were owed the following amounts:

- (a) Dian & Estelle Paul - \$50,033.11
- (b) Erlo (me) and Christa - \$73,851.40
- (c) Estelle Paul (Hester) - \$2,817.36



43. The Rand-value of the amounts owed to us, at an exchange rate of R17.30 to the US Dollar, is R14,736,056.60.
44. On 19 May 2020, after not receiving any payments from the respondent, an email titled "UPDATE" was received. A true copy thereof is annexed hereto as "FA23". The email informed investors that, instead of weekly payments, the respondent had unilaterally decided to make only two payments, being a first payment of the original capital invested by 31 May 2020, and a second payment of "profit and growth" by mid-July. The remainder of the email again contained a plea directed at investors not to take legal action against the respondent and attempted to convince investors of Breedt's sincerity.
45. On 20 May 2020 the respondent addressed an email to investors informing them that there were, according to Breedt, two possible options, being to allow him to make payments as promised, or to take legal action and to thereby delay payments to investors. A true copy of this email is annexed hereto as "FA24".




46. The very last communication from the respondent was received on 26 May 2020 and simply informed investors that: "... *all initial capital payments are still on track for the 31st of May 2020*".
47. As I depose to this affidavit 31 May 2020 has come and gone, and not a single cent has been paid to any of the Paul-family investors. To the best of my understanding certain very limited payments were made to some investors, and such payments were identified as 'test-payments'. The payments were, so I understand, insignificant when compared to the amounts owed to the investors in question.
48. During the third week of June 2020 I managed to speak to Breedt and demanded payment of all amounts owed to the Paul-family investors. Breedt informed me that the respondent's trading accounts (held and operated at virtual banks) were frozen and that he was unable to make payments. Breedt further admitted that he (i.e. the respondent) had lost money through some trades, but according to him an amount of R225 million remained in the respondent's virtual accounts.
49. Recent media reports have claimed that a group of approximately 500 disgruntled investors obtained an interdict to suspend (freeze) Breedt's personal bank accounts, and that litigation to sequestrate Breedt's estate might be pending. Although I have no personal knowledge of such litigation, it appears likely that investors will litigate and attempt to secure payments from the respondent and from Breedt. This is one of the reasons why an order for



the respondent's liquidation is important, so that liquidators can take orderly control of the respondent's affairs and immediately take steps against Breedt to prevent him from dissipating the respondent's assets or funds.

50. On 22 June 2020 my son, Dian Paul, and I consulted with legal representatives and we were advised that an application for the respondent's liquidation should be launched. Up until this time we still believed the excuses conjured up by Breedt and did not believe that our investments may have formed part of a multiplication scheme. It now seems unlikely that the respondent's business was ever legitimate and it appears that Breedt may have defrauded hundreds (possibly thousands) of investors. It further appears that very large amounts of funds were invested in the scheme perpetrated by the respondent.

[E] BASIS FOR THE RESPONDENT'S LIQUIDATION

51. The available information suggests that the respondent is both factually and commercially insolvent. Factual insolvency refers to a situation where liabilities exceed the reasonable value of assets. Put differently, it refers to a negative balance sheet position. Commercial insolvency refers to an inability to pay debts (i.e. to a negative cash flow position).



52. To the best of my knowledge the respondent does not own any movable or immovable assets. I annex hereto, as "FA25", a printout from the records of the Registrar of Deeds confirming that the respondent does not own any immovable properties.
53. It appears that the respondent was used by Breedt to conduct an illegal multiplication scheme. The respondent received deposits from members of the public without being registered to do so in terms of the Banks Act, 1990 (the Banks Act). In term of the Banks Act no person may conduct the "*business of a bank*" unless registered as a public company and authorised to do so by the Prudential Authority. The phrase "*business of a bank*" is defined in the Banks Act to refer to the soliciting or advertising for, or the acceptance of, deposits from the general public as a regular feature of the business.
54. As the respondent's business model included soliciting and acceptance of deposits, its business model clearly contravenes the Banks Act. The illegality of the respondent's business model justifies the respondent's immediate liquidation so that liquidators can commence with an investigation into the respondent's affairs to determine how Breedt dealt with the 'invested' funds.
55. As a company with very significant admitted liabilities, and an admitted inability to pay such liabilities, the respondent should be placed in final liquidation in terms of section 344 of the Companies Act.



[F] URGENCY

56. I respectfully submit that an order for the respondent's liquidation is self-evidently urgent and desirable.
57. The respondent is involved in illicit business dealings and should not be allowed to continue to exist under Breedt's control, but should rather be placed under a liquidator's control to ensure that any available remaining funds be secured for the benefit of the body of creditors.
58. In addition, an urgent liquidation order will ensure that liquidators can take immediate steps to trace payments from the respondent's bank accounts and to determine what the respondent did with the funds deposited by investors.
59. By way of example, I have determined that Breedt owns approximately 13 vehicles and 3 motorcycles. To own such an inordinate number of vehicles and motorcycles is a strange occurrence, and it is likely that these assets were acquired with funds flowing from the respondent. If I am correct, liquidators can (and will) take immediate steps to secure the said assets for the benefit of the respondent's general body of creditors.
60. With the benefit of hindsight I should have consulted attorneys sooner. I, however, believed the excuses conjured up by Breedt and trusted that the promised payments would be made. I humbly submit that my trust in humanity should not be held against me when the urgency of this application is



adjudicated. I only came to realise that something was wrong during mid-June 2020, and thereafter arranged a consultation with my attorneys of record to provide guidance.

61. Should this application be presented in the ordinary motion court Breedts will be allowed to retain exclusive control over the respondent's affairs and will be given further opportunities to spirit funds (and possible assets) away. Such a situation will be detrimental to creditors, and should be avoided.

[G] FORMALITIES

62. I am unaware of any employees currently in the respondent's permanent employment, but I am aware that my son and daughter, Dian and Nadia, previously spoke to persons names Lynette, Ashley and Michelle, who acted as representatives of the respondent. I obviously do not know if they were employees or simply contracted representatives. As such, the sheriff will be instructed to serve this application on possible employees in the manner prescribed by section 346(4A) of the Companies Act. Should the sheriff find employees, the sheriff will be requested to determine if any employees belong to a registered trade union and, if so, the sheriff will be instructed to serve a copy of this application on such trade union.
63. My legal representative will ensure that a copy of this application is delivered to the Commissioner for the South African Revenue Service.

64. I annex hereto, as "FA28", a certificate issued by the Master of the High Court of South Africa to the effect that sufficient security has been provided for the payment of all fees and charges necessary for the prosecution of, and all costs of administering the respondent's liquidated estate until a provisional liquidator is appointed or, if no provisional liquidator is appointed, of all fees and charges necessary for the discharge the provisional liquidation order.

65. The following confirmatory affidavits are annexed hereto:

- (a) Nadia Paul - annexure "FA26"; and
- (b) Dian Paul - annexure "FA27".

WHEREFORE the applicant respectfully prays for an order as detailed in the prefixed notice of motion.

We apologise to all members that we didn't give the full information as provided in this letter earlier. We will keep to this schedule and insure that every single member is paid. This has been an extremely busy time for VaultAge Solutions. I hope that members understand frustrations to deal with and specially being the time of year that it is.

We have 3 trading accounts:

- 1. Bitmex: 85% of fund traded here
2. Bitfinex: 10% of fund traded here
3. Bitfex: 5% of fund traded here

We only trade up to 50% of the fund available on each platform. The full fund is not traded at any time or this early for a while.

As the crypto world and the use of crypto develops as payment method more and more regulations will come through to make sure the traders are legit. Along with the Blockchain wallet that we have not been able to access the last 3 weeks have really caused major delays. The flow of profit will then be enough to make sure every member is paid on time as per schedule. INCLUDING AREAS PAYMENTS.

We sincerely apologise to every member and what stressed it caused over the last months. We have been working on everything to make sure nothing like this will happen again and that no matter what happens we can stick to the payment schedule.

- 1. I also want to explain the Rest of transactions all the way to your wallet:

We receive the profits weekly from the trading platforms into our profit wallet (this one to be Blockchain wallet that we currently create use) we hold as crypto. Now wallet in which we receive the funds.
2. From the profit wallet we do this part of members manually. But now we transfer the funds to the payroll category and they then distribute it to all the members.

We don't want to make any empty promises regarding payments, or transaction information, and it is very clear that we need to get the firm issues, Bitmex and Blockchain wallet resolved. We need for all that everyone be patient just a little longer. We will be able to start with our payment schedule again on Tuesday as those issues will be sorted by then. I understand that the members have concerns but I don't want to make any empty promises that I know we cannot currently fulfill. We need to be very accurate from now on.

RE: Some Facts

I decided to write this letter, and some members will say more excuses. But this is necessary for clarity. I will not give names or want to start any fights with anyone.

These are the facts:

1. Our Binance account with 80% of the funds was blocked by Binance compliance November 2019. It took me far longer than expected to get this sorted. There was a lot of documentation and compliance demands. This had a massive impact on profit payout and the ability to do any trades for profit.
2. Our Blockchain wallet that we have been using for more than 2 years suddenly gave us intermitted problems when they updated the app late last year. Finally, the wallet would not open with the same technical error every time we tried from the 16th of December 2019. The "ERROR, we are experiencing a service issue that may effect displayed balances. Don't worry your funds are safe." I will add a screenshot of this message taken this morning. Yes, this is persisting with no real help from Blockchain support. I will add a screenshot of their reply in the last week. There is a large \$ amount stuck in that wallet. We even requested that we can fly to Blockchain HQ and sit with a technician to help but they wouldn't allow that. This even caused more problems. One member residing in Europe even started interacting with blockchain on my behalf from January 2020 and have been getting the same run around support.
3. Most of the members paid in December and January were payments I made from my private account to assist. These members know who they are I will not mention them without consent. Some of them even heading in the smear campaign against VaultAge Solutions currently floating around. Some of those were even so-called agents that earned a commission on the members they referred after coming to me and asking please if they can earn a commission because of their current financial situation. VaultAge Solutions has no referral program but I wanted to assist them.
4. We have been trading again and even though the markets are very volatile we have been able to produce a decent profit. The current market is extremely difficult. Markets literally change in minutes.
5. We have and are still struggling to do the payouts faster. But we are working on and have solutions for this already and we will have it running for end of April 2020 payouts
6. We are busy testing our app internally to make sure we have the admin side 100% ready before going into testing with a small number of members and will then roll out to all members.

You can see out of the above letter where my heart lies and what we are doing to improve VaultAge Solutions. We are not perfect but we are here to stay and will get everything running as it should soon. The Crypto space is not a market where you find of the shelf solutions ready to go.

1. I am an adult male person who currently resides at 17 Soetdoring Street, Bela Bela, Limpopo, 0480.
2. The facts contained in this affidavit fall within my personal knowledge, unless the contrary appears from the context hereof, and I confirm such facts to be true and correct.
3. Pursuant to the completion of my founding affidavit certain further relevant facts came to my attention. In my respectful opinion these facts contribute to the adjudication of this application.
4. Late on Friday 3 July 2020 I received a *WhatsApp*-message on a group formed amongst certain of the respondent's investors alleging that Breedt's estate had been sequestered, that he had been found (located) in the Silver Lakes Golf Estate in Pretoria, and that electronic equipment used to gain access to crypto currency had been confiscated. A printout from the aforesaid message is annexed hereto as "**SA1**".
5. On Monday 6 July 2020 I instructed my attorneys to make enquiries to determine the veracity of the above information. It was subsequently determined that an order for the provisional sequestration of Breedt's estate was in fact issued. A true copy of such order is annexed hereto as "**SA2**". I was unaware of this order prior to Monday 6 July 2020.

6. It was also determined that the Port Elizabeth High Court issued orders suspending transactions on the respondent's and also on Breedt's bank accounts. It seems that this application was presented on an *ex parte* basis *in camera*.
7. It is now, even more than before, necessary for the urgent appointment of a liquidator to take control of the respondent's assets. This includes access to the crypto currency wallets and all '*dongles*' permitting access to such funds. I again point out that during my last communication with Breedt he alleged that an amount of R225 million was still available in the crypto currency accounts.
8. The media reports suggest that capital amounts of R800 million was invested with the respondent and it is therefore necessary to determine what has happened to the balance of the funds (i.e. the difference between R800 million and R225 million) and to take urgent steps to either secure or recover such funds. No doubt, the passage of time will create further opportunities for Breedt to hide or dissipate funds and assets.
