MTI ENQUIRIES: COMPLIANCE WITH WITNESS SUMMONSES

It has come to our attention, that there may be a general perception amongst investors/members that there is no obligation on any of them to attend insolvency enquiries pursuant to witness summonses having been lawfully issued and served, calling on them to appear before Commissioners.

This perception is wrong and prospective witnesses are cautioned that, unless they fully comply with the witness summonses served on them and duly attend, they may face the consequence of such refusal, which may include criminal charge and/or a warrant being issued to bring the witness before the Commissioner (where the Commissioners is a Magistrate), with the assistance of members of the SAPS.

The consequences of non-compliance are therefore severe.

Members/investors must know that the order obtained in the Western Cape High Court, only applies to certain witnesses and in a particular set of circumstances and is of no general application whatsoever.

An extract of the relevant portion of the order granted in the Western Cape High Court by the Honourable Justice Baartman in respect of the applicants in that matter, reads as follows:

9. Pending the final determination of this application, the interrogation of the applicants in the commission of enquiry under Sections 417 and 418 of the Companies Act 61 of 1973, authorised in terms of the order of this Court under case number 935/2021 dated 22 January 2021, is stayed.
